

# How to register for the first time


# 1. Open the registration form





A registration form has to be filled out for every participant. There is the option of selecting a combined family invoice by matching other family members' names.

# 2. Register as a new member




Click or tap the **Register** button.

Click or tap the **Next step** button.

Enter the participant's first name, last name and date of birth (for data matching purposes), and then select the registration type (associate membership is for non-participating members).

3. Enter registration information and payment



Enter all the requested information to the best of your knowledge. An asterisk (\*) denotes a required field.

Insert the phone number and email address for the individual that is FINANCIALLY RESPONSIBLE for the participant in the Contact details section. Additional email addresses can be entered; however, invoices will not be sent to these addresses, they will only be used to send for disseminating Club information.

Sports vouchers can be used for children aged 5 to 15 years by completing the Sports vouchers for 5 to 15 year old children section. The sports voucher discount will be applied to the selected invoice frequency type, either annual lump sum or the term 1 instalment.

Enter credit card details to pay for the participant's registration. Please note that credit card details are not stored. Separate invoices will be issued for the remainder of the fees.

Click or tap the **Confirm registration** button.

You are now registered! Look out for an email with your login details to our site. Once you set your password, you will be able to view and update your details and pay invoices.

#### Registration

Registration for the 2022 calisthenics year will open on our website at 12:00pm on Monday, 17 January 2022.

Registration is due by 30 January 2022 for returning members, and 13 February 2022 for new members, to cover insurance. Without insurance, training is not permitted. In addition to insurance, this payment allows members to take part in South Australian competitions as it includes the Calisthenics Association of South Australia (CASA) affiliation fees. This fee also covers general administration and music copyright.

#### Lesson Fees

Lesson fees cover the associated costs of running lessons such as coaches' wages, hall hire, stage rehearsals, lighting, team entry fees and tuition as well as hair & make-up and fundraising levies.

If the *term instalment* option is selected at registration, then these fees are divided into three equal payments with invoices sent out in week 3 of term 1 and week 2 of terms 2 and 3. There is no instalment for term 4. Each instalment is to be paid by the due date on the invoice (two weeks after issue) or members will no longer be permitted to train. However, weekly or fortnightly regular payments can be arranged if this is not achievable. If the *annual lump sum* option is selected, then an invoice will be issued in week 3 of term 1 with a 5% discount on lesson fees. As with the term instalment option, the invoice is to be paid by the due date (two weeks after issue) or the member will no longer be permitted to train. The 5% discount will also be removed. Siblings attract a 10% discount on lesson fees.

Costume fees, which are included in the annual lump sum/term instalments invoice, cover the costs associated with the hire or trimming of club or privately owned costumes or making of new costumes and headpieces. A new rod for competition use is also included. This year, new clubs have been purchased and provided to members, however, if additional new clubs are required then this may incur a separate charge. The cost of any wigs or shoes required may be an additional charge.

Lesson fees do not include:

- team tanks organised by the team manager in term 1 (usually \$25);
- bodyboards organised by a costume mistress/committee member (usually \$10);
- aesthetic practice skirts;
- tanning (if required) payable by members at the time of tanning;
- end of year gifts for coaches/assistants.

Please note that lessons fees MUST be paid in order to participate in pupil skills and the Solo/Duo season.

# Sports Vouchers

In 2022, children aged 5 to 15 years old (inclusive) will be eligible for a South Australian Government sports voucher (these children will have a year of birth from 2007 to 2017). Eligible members can check the *Use sports voucher?* option during registration and enter the relevant Medicare details to offset lesson fees. For term instalments, this will be deducted in the term 1 invoice. For more information about the sports voucher scheme, visit the Office of Recreation and Sport website.

### Club Camp

The annual Brighton Calisthenics Club camp will again be held at Nunyara on 3-5 June 2022. Registration for camp will open on 1 May 2022 through our website and payment will be required at registration. Further information will be provided closer to the time.

# Club Merchandise

A club tracksuit is mandatory for all members. If you require a new tracksuit, but not sure about sizing, come to one of our "try on" sessions. Dates and times for these sessions will be emailed to members, as well as published on the BCC private Facebook page. Tracksuits and polos are required to be ordered through our website no later than 5:00pm on Sunday, 27 February 2022.

## **Pupil Skills**

Pupil skills lessons for the December 2022 exams will be held during October and November (dates to be confirmed) and are an additional cost to lesson fees. As stated above, all lesson fees are required to be paid to be eligible to register for these pupil skills lessons. Members will need to register and pay through our website. Additionally, members will also need to register with CASA to undertake the exam. While not compulsory for team competitions, pupil skills are required for those members who wish to compete in the CASA Graceful Girl and Solo/Duo competitions. More information will be provided closer to the time about costs and dates.
